Mary Helen gives teacher training workshops throughout the US and has published 4 books of Orff materials. She has recently taught Level II and III at the University of Waikato in Hamilton, New Zealand. In 1998 she received the Gladys Prior Award for Career Teaching from the University of North Florida.
